1 Chair / Vice-Chair

The EMVA 1288 working group is led by one chair and one vice-chairs. The EMVA 1288 chairs are elected for a period of three years according to the EMVA Standards Development and Approval Procedures document (SDAP). The voting takes place during the regular meetings

2 Sub-Chair for EMVA 1288 Reference Implementation

For the EMVA 1288 Reference Implementation the EMVA 1288 working group appoints a sub-chair.

3 Future Sub Groups

If in the future further sub-groups will be formed, the same rules apply as for the EMVA 1288 reference implementation sub-chair.

4 IPR Management Committee

EMVA 1288 uses the Fiduciary Regime as described in detail in both the EMVA Standards Development and Approval Procedures and the EMVA IPR Committee Rules document. The associated IPR management committee is assigned the EMVA 1288 reference code.

The voting for each of the two delegates follows the rules for electing a vice-chair as described in the SDAP. The IPR management committee delegates have an imperative mandate, that is they represent the EMVA 1288 working group in the IPR management committee and negotiate with the EMVA delegates until a, for all parties, acceptable solution is found. Before the EMVA 1288 delegates can finally agree to a solution they need to get approval by the members of the EMVA 1288 working group with a 2/3 majority according to section 4.4b SDAP.

No further rules are required. The rules established in the SDAP are sufficient for a success activity of the EMVA 1288 working group.
